


Corruption in Africa: Insights from the citizen perspective

1 Perception of increased corruption



A majority of Africans say corruption increased in the past year, with notable surges in Senegal (+39 percentage points) and Burkina Faso (+28) and a huge drop in Benin (-61).

2 COVID-19 pandemic and corruption



More than two-thirds believe substantial resources for the COVID-19 response were lost to corruption.



3 Police corruption



Almost half of Africans perceive most or all police officials as corrupt, the highest among key public institutions.



4 Bribery in accessing public services

Among citizens who sought key public services during the past year, many had to pay bribes.



5 Government performance in fighting corruption

Two-thirds of Africans say their governments are performing poorly in combating corruption.



6 Fear of retaliation

Only 26% believe one can report corruption without fear of retaliation.
